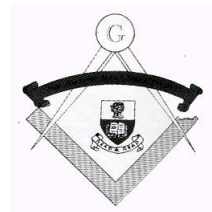


West Buckland School Lodge No. 9037

The lodge was formed to create a School Lodge for old boys and members of the staff, and also with the hope of encouraging past pupils to become freemasons. The lodge was consecrated on 11 September 1982 at West Buckland School where it still meets. The mother lodge is Loyal No. 251. The members come from far and wide leaving little time for rehearsals, and the ceremonies reflect bits of different working from all over the country. During the Foot and Mouth Epidemic in 2001 the lodge met in the Braunton temple, to prevent any possible spread of this disease.

The lodge meets at West Buckland School, West Buckland on the first Friday in April and May, and September to November.
